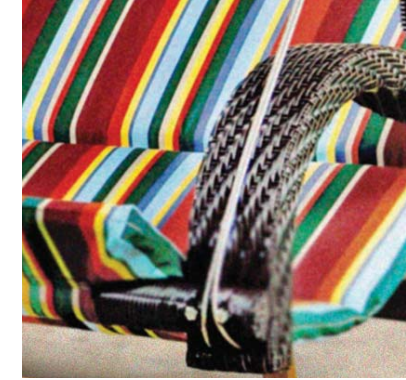

The **UrbanBalance Expanse** is made from premier quality materials with strict attention paid to the highest manufacturing standards. It comes with a generous 3 year limited warranty and permission to share. Please read these instructions carefully. The proper installation and care of your **UrbanBalance Expanse** will ensure many years of comfort and relaxation.

Installing the eyelag

Locate ceiling joist (by Stud Finder or tapping and verifying with a small nail). Be sure to locate exact center. Using a 3/16" (3mm) drill bit, drill a hole approx. 4" (10cm) deep, perpendicular to the ceiling. Screw in the two supplied eyelags until all threads have disappeared into the joist. Make certain the distance apart is approximately 49". Do not loosen or adjust once in place. Important: Holes must be directly in the center of the studs for maximum weight bearing capacity. Failure to do so could cause eyelags to loosen.

Assembling and hanging the UrbanBalance Expanse

Locate all UrbanBalance Expanse parts. These should include:

- cushion piece (1)
- cupholders (2)

- set of resin wicker arms (2)
- set of spreader bars (2)
- hardware pack with 8 hex head bolts, washers, 8 nuts
- 2 eyelags, 4 S hooks, 2 sets of chains

Place the 2 resin wicker arms about 50" apart on a flat surface and place the padded cushion between the upward sloping wicker arms. (Make sure the cables are facing upwards.) Slide the two long round spreader bars through the sleeves on the underside of the pad.

Locate and remove the 8 machine bolts, nuts and washers from the hardware bag. Insert the 8 bolts (2 for each corner of the chair) through the holes on the round spreader bars, lining them up with the corresponding holes on the wicker arms.

Be sure the cables are not tangled or caught behind the spreader bars. They must be free and clear when lifting the chair up.

After all the bolts are placed into the respective holes, thread the washers over the bolts, from the underside of the chair and then screw on the nuts. With a person on each side, raise the chair onto the eye lags with the "S" hooks provided. If the eyelags are too high, use the chain provided to bridge the gap.

The chair should now be at a comfortable

sitting height. Make sure that all the cables are secure and that the eyelags are properly installed. Also make sure all the bolts are well tightened. Sit on the chair gently as it will stretch at first. You can always take up the slack at a later time.

Important reminders

- The UrbanBalance Expanse is NOT a swing. We highly recommend using only a gentle 'to and fro' motion.
- Check the eyelags from time to time to make sure it's holding fast.
- A periodic visual inspection of the cables and other hardware is recommended.
- Use a readily available fabric protector on the pad to resist stains.
- We highly recommend hanging no more than 18" above the ground.
- The UrbanBalance Expanse has a rated load of 500 pounds.
- Enhance your relaxation with optional outbacksprings and footrests.

Washing & care instructions

Your UrbanBalance Expanse will last longer depending on its use, where it is installed and the care it is given. It will last longer if you keep it dry and store it indoors when not in use. To wash, scrub gently with a soft brush and a mixture of water and a mild laundry detergent.

Warning: Do not use any synthetic cleaning agents or solvents as this will affect the resin wicker.

About your warranty

As with all Outback Company products, your UrbanBalance Expanse is made to withstand the elements. This product carries a 3-year limited warranty against all manufacturing defects. The frame of your UrbanBalance Expanse is manufactured from lightweight aluminum and is epoxy coated for extra protection. It will not rust outside in any climate. The resin wicker is extremely resistant to the elements. This translates into a chair that is, simply put, maintenance free.
